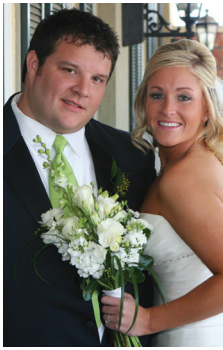


417 wedding announcement

A computer file of your write-up

As a Microsoft Word document on a CD. Please title the document with the bride's maiden name and the groom's last name (e.g. Jones-Smith.doc). Word count limit is 450 words. Write-ups that are too long will be edited. We cannot accept the write-up by Email. Do not type your write-up in all caps.

A printed copy of your write-up

This helps us in the event that there is a problem with the computer document.

2 photos

On CD, as high-resolution, digital images (300 dpi at 5x7). Share these specifications with your photographer. **We cannot accept photos by Email.** (CD's will not be returned.)

The photo of the couple will be the larger photo. Please do not send more than the allotted number of photos for your page. Do not send photo collages. We will strive to produce pleasing color, but we cannot guarantee an exact color match.

If digital photos are not available, there will be a **\$75** fee for scanning prints. Prints should be sharp and clear, and labeled with a sticky note on back (do not write on prints). Please note that *417 Magazine* will not be held responsible for the print quality of scanned photos. If scanning yourself, make sure they are scanned at 300 dpi at approximately 5x7. Include a self-addressed, stamped photo mailer (preferably a flat-rate USPS envelope mailer) if you would like your photos returned.
